Last month NZ Transport . . .

- Completed laying all the base slabs in the trench.
- Began installing pre-cast slabs along the walls of the trench
- Began installing barriers in the median strip in the trench

Landing Drive roundabout upgrade

- Completed the locating of buried services on the north east corner.
- Temporarily relocated street lights to allow them to carry out the work on north east and south east corners.
- Started installing a new water main on the north east corner to divert an existing water main.
- Installed temporary footpaths and cycle paths.
- Started work relocating an existing communications chamber.
- Installed the erosion and sediment controls needed to carry out ground work during the winter months.
- Completed clearing the trees.
- Relocated power and communications poles on the north east corner.

Works planned for this month . . . (Note: work is weather dependent and timings can change)

Kirkbride Road east

They will continue to install services and lay pavement from House Park to Kirkbride Road/SH20A intersection. They will be completing the fence outside the Mangere Central Primary School.

Kirkbride Road west

They continue to construction retaining walls.

Ascot Road

They continue to install drainage and lay pavement and will complete work outside the Hotel Grande this month.

SH20A

They continue to install pre-caste slabs along the walls of the trench and to construct the entranceways to the trench.

They plan to open the trench to traffic in August 2017.

They continue to work in the middle area of the motorway.

Landing Drive/SH20A

They plan to:

- Complete the location of buried services on the south east corner.
- Complete the installation of the new water main on the north east corner.
- Install the new water main on the south east corner.
- Protect an existing high voltage power cable on the north east corner.
- Relocate power and communications cables on the north east corner.
- Relocate power and communications cables on the south east corner.
- Start work on the new shared path on the south east corner.
